Taylor Lodge Update

We reported to you in our Fall 2009 Newsletter that work had begun on the north wing of Taylor Lodge. Much progress has been made and the work on the building is coming to a close. The transformation of the north wing is as dramatic as that of the south and we will begin using the building, with its new look and added level of comfort, beginning the weekend of February 27 and 28.

The remainder of work on this project is primarily related to the center section of the building. This area will include: meeting space, laundry facilities, a new kitchen, and a small apartment at the rear for use by our summer health care staff and perhaps year round interns. It is estimated that it we will require additional funding of about \$100,000 to complete this area of Taylor Lodge.

We are enjoying showing off our new building to people visiting the campsite, so if you would like a tour, please do not hesitate to stop by.
