Welcome to your special week at camp. Each of the junior programs is based on our non-competitive philosophy that values individual just as they are. You'll swim, boat, sing, worship, have campfires, and devote extra time to the following specialty you have selected:

Sports Zone (Events 1210 (cabins) and 5210 (tents))

Campers will experience a different game each day - basketball, volleyball, kickball, and flag football - all non-competitive. You will also enjoy Johnsonburg's everyday activities.

Waterworld Camp (Events 1220 (tents) and 6220 (cabins))

This unit is for those who love the water. You will spend extra time at the pool and lake and do lots of other water-oriented activities. There is no specific swimming ability necessary.

Archery Skills (Events 2230 and 7230) (both in tents)

This unit will be led by a counselor trained by the American Archery Association who will work with each camper to improve their archery skills. We will play archery games and challenge ourselves to improve our skills. In addition to regular camp activities, campers who elect this event will have one archery session each day. The focus is on fun, relaxation, and observing progress against self-established goals.

Girl Power (Event 2240) (in cabins)

This unit for girls will celebrate what it means to be a girl today. Campers will talk in age-appropriate terms about body image, conflict resolution, forming and expressing opinions, and nurturing relationships. We'll also laugh, sing, talk about normal girl stuff, and have fun understanding ourselves as unique and loved by God.

Specialty Sampler (Event 3250) (in cabins) New for 2010!

This event is for those who can't decide which of the specialty units to do. No worries, we will make the choice for you. We'll spend one day each doing activities from these favorite specialty units: waterworld, extreme, archery skills, cookout, and sports zone. We'll still have time for other camp activities like swimming, hiking and boating.

Extreme Camp (Event 3260 and 7260) (both in tents)

Explore the extreme world of Camp Johnsonburg. Campers will participate in normal camp activities taken to the extreme, with events like slip'n slide, polar archery, and more. The sky is the limit!

Crafty Campers II (Event 4270 (cabins)) New for 2010!

This unit was so popular last year for Elementaries we decided to add one for Juniors as well. Come explore your creative side as you'll spend extra time doing arts and crafts, but still have plenty of time for favorite camp activities.

Explorers (4280 (tents))

This unit will give campers an opportunity for a more rustic camping experience. Campers will have a base unit in the main part of camp, but will choose a site in the woods, build a shelter, learn how to make fires and cook outdoors, and ultimately leave the woods without any trace of their presence having been there.

Safe Sitter (Event 5290 (cabins))

Designed for those who are already babysitting, or who desire to begin this age-old first job. Using the nationally recognized Safe Sitter curriculum, campers will learn to handle crisis and to keep children safe and secure. Campers will also learn CPR and participate in regular camp activities.

Cookout Camp (Event 6295 (tents))

This unit is for you if you love to help cook your own meals. Typically each unit at Johnsonburg cooks out twice during the week. This unit will cook out at least one meal per day, sometimes more. We'll look at the variety of dishes that can be prepared over an open fire, and the many methods of cooking out. No experience necessary!
